

Medical Missionary Course Outline

(Medical Missionary Training Educates the Hands for Today, Tomorrow & Forever)

Objective and Overview

The objective of this course is to prepare children and youth to become Medical Missionaries, as it is the last line of ministerial work that would be done on earth before Christ comes. As they follow on to know Christ and take up the work He Himself has done, they partake of His very life and become co-laborers together with Him in fulfilling His mission. The principles as laid out in the Bible and the Testimonies will be utilized in theory and practice. Children and youth will learn how to apply laws that govern health, assess health conditions, and draft up health programs to assist in helping others to regain health.

Our church schools are ordained by God to prepare the children for this great work. Here children are to be instructed in the special truths for this time and in practical missionary work. They are to enlist in the army of workers to help the sick and the suffering. Children can take part in the medical missionary work and by their jots and tittles can help to carry it forward. Their investments may be small, but every little helps, and by their efforts many souls will be won to the truth. By them God's message will be made known and His saving health to all nations. Then let the church carry a burden for the lambs of the flock. Let the children be educated and trained to do service for God, for they are the Lord's heritage. { CCh 211.1}

The only hope of better things is in the education of the people in right principles. Let physicians teach the people that **restorative power is not in drugs, but in nature**. **Disease is an effort of nature to free the system from conditions that result from a violation of the laws of health**. In case of sickness, the cause should be ascertained. Unhealthful conditions should be changed, wrong habits corrected. Then nature is to be assisted in her effort to expel impurities and to re-establish right conditions in the system.—The Ministry of Healing, 127. { Te 85.4}
